# How to get a 7,8 or even 9 at GCSE **in your exam!**

- Complete all **exam checklist tasks** fully asap=‘Consistency’.
- To go above and beyond the basic requirements in written and practical work=‘Exceptional ability’ Attempt all **EXT tasks** on checklist.
- To have the ‘wow’ factor when you look at/read your work=‘Exceptional ability’.
- Your **exam project ‘Found’ should flow** from beginning to end and any change in direction with idea or resources should be clearly explained and justified=‘Consistency’
- Is everything thoroughly researched, physically tested out, planned and evaluated not just completed and dismissed?=‘Consistency’
- Is your **timed 10-hour final piece a sustained piece of work**, e.g. resulting in your skills being refined and your **idea fully realised linking to the exam theme ‘Found’**?=‘Exceptional’

## Awarding and reporting

This qualification will be graded, awarded and certificated to comply with the requirements of Ofqual's General Conditions of Recognition.

The raw marks for components 1 and 2 in this qualification will be scaled by Pearson to represent the relative weighting of 60% for Component 1 and 40% for Component 2. Any marks submitted by the centre should be in raw marks based on the assessment grids for components 1 and 2.
