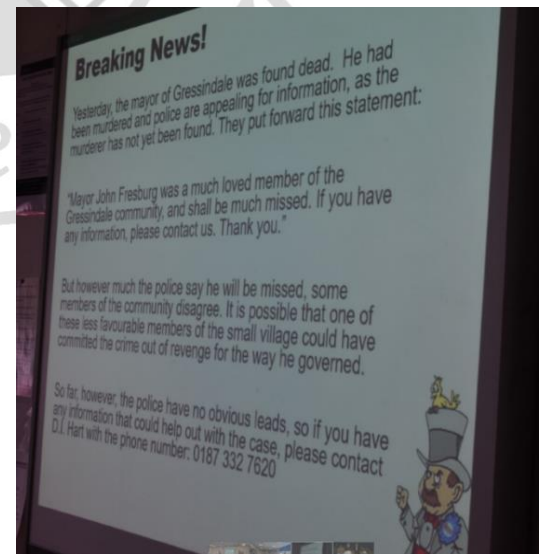
Dear Parents and Carers

## History Club

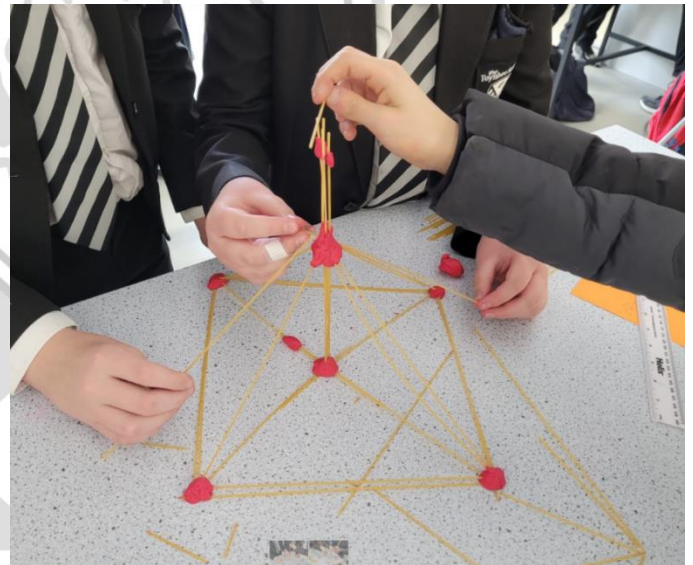
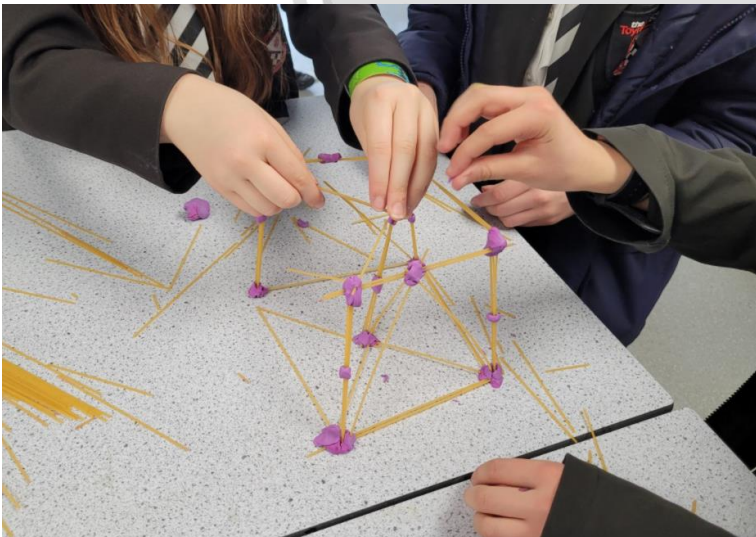
