

Toynbee School Uniform Guide - 2026

Pupil Uniform:

- Choice of either:
 - Plain Black Blazer with embroidered badge (available from [Skoolkit](#))*
 - Plain Black Sweatshirt with embroidered badge (available from [Skoolkit](#))
- Choice of either:
 - Grey Tartan Box Pleat Skirt (available from [Skoolkit](#))
 - Black tailored trousers (not leggings, jeans or jeggings – not tight material).
 - Black school tailored shorts
- Plain white long or short sleeved shirt
- Clip on School Tie (available from the school or [Skoolkit](#))
- Plain black leather or vinyl school shoes. Canvas shoes, trainers, boots or pumps are not permitted. In addition, shoes with 'air bubbles', different coloured branding/laces or shoes that are noticeably used for sports are also not allowed.
- Black or grey woollen tights
- Black, grey or white (non-logoed) ankle socks
- Suitable coat
- Suitable bag

*Parents may purchase a Plain Black Blazer from a supplier other than [Skoolkit](#). The school badge can be purchased separately (available from Toynbee Reception or [Skoolkit](#)) and sewn onto the left breast pocket.

Standards of appearance:

- Make-up (including false eyelashes) is discouraged, excessive make-up will be challenged. Jewellery, false nails, coloured nail varnish are not permitted in school.
- Girls and boys with pierced ears should, for reasons of safety, wear stud earrings. Small clear retainers or studs are allowed as a nose piercing. No other visible body or facial piercings are allowed, this includes tongue piercing, spikes and expanders. This is not an exclusive list.
- Extreme hairstyles (including colours) must be avoided:
 - No tramlines, razor cuts, beading, hair extensions, non-natural hair or coloured braiding
- Trainers are not to be worn as normal footwear.
- Hoodies, tracksuit tops, sweatshirts or garments with branding or slogans are not permitted.

This is not an exclusive list. Final judgement will always rest with the Senior Leadership Team, SENCO and Guidance Managers.



PE Uniform:

- Choice of either:
 - PE Polo Shirt available from [Skoolkit](#)
 - Plain Black (no branding or visible logos) T-Shirt or polo shirt
- Black shorts, skorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Trainers
- Any appropriate sports socks
- Football boots for rugby or football (metal studs are not allowed on the synthetic pitch)
- Shin pads (your child's PE teacher will inform you when Shin Pads will be required)
- Gum shield for rugby

If a pupil represents the school in a sporting activity, a Toynbee PE Sports Top will be loaned to them if they do not already have one.

Where to obtain the uniform:

Toynbee uniform is available from [SkoolKit: https://www.skoolkit.co.uk/school-uniform/114](https://www.skoolkit.co.uk/school-uniform/114). Certain other items (e.g. shirts and trousers) can be brought from a retail outlet of your choice (e.g. Marks and Spencer, John Lewis, Asda and Tesco or alternatively from [Skoolkit](#)).

Ties: You will be able to buy the school tie from the school or [Skoolkit](#). Stock will be available in school during term time. All pupils wear a black and grey striped tie.

Badges: If the Blazer does not have the Toynbee embroidered badge, these can be purchased from the school reception. They should be hand sewn onto the blazer, positioned at the left breast pocket.
