Study Environment

- Workbox of pens etc. Keep topping up
- Have a set file for revising each subject
- Buy ONE good revision aid-be selective
- Past papers
- Flashcards/Revision cards
- Water
- Food

How can parents/carers support?

- Do not allow child to believe they are not good at something
- Do not allow siblings to put down aspirations
- Stress the power of hard work
- Stress the power of practice
- Praise effort not achievement
- Support revision practice-be the project manager
- Discuss learning challenges with the child
- Be their "learning advocate" with school

A child is continually late to school and this lateness is unauthorised for 10 or more sessions.


Session = a half day School starts at 8.40

Being Late adds up to a loss of learning

- If you are 5 minutes late every day that adds up to over 3 days lost each year
- 15 minutes late is the same as being absent for 2 weeks a year.


