I'm extremely proud of the 90, they made this trip the best of the nine I've been involved in.

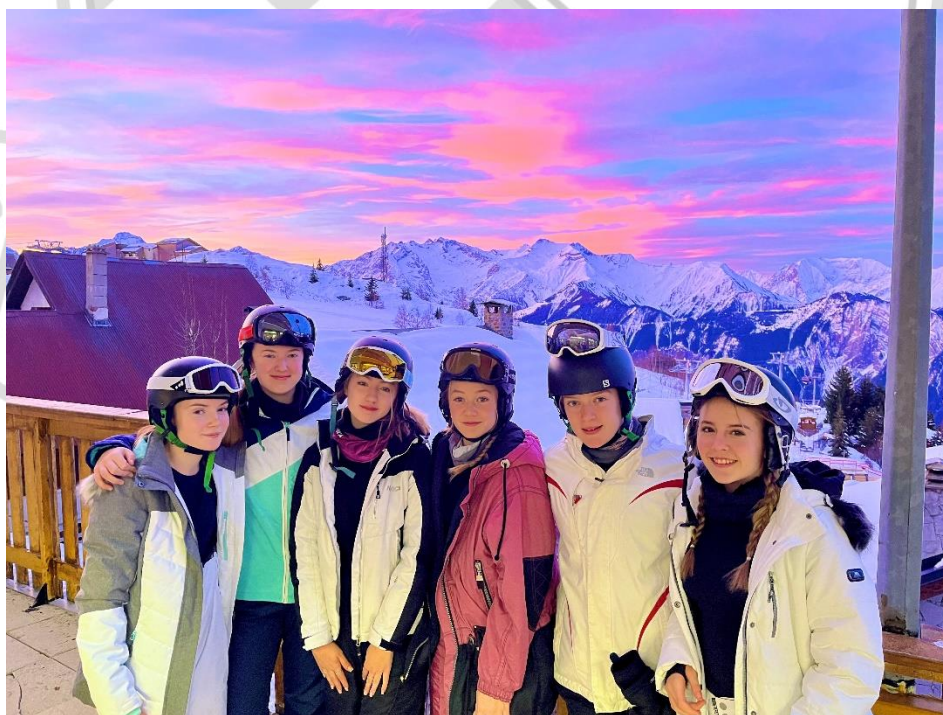
