LA Trip

On the 9th February, Toynbee's Media Studies department took 42 pupils and 5 staff to the bright lights of Los Angeles! The pupils engaged in several media-based activities, including studies of sound production at Sony Studios, special effects production at Warner Bros. studios, and stunts and pyrotechnics at Universal Studios, as well as tours of working TV and movie sets on the backlots and sound stages. Of course, they also had some time sampling the film-based rides of the Universal Studios Theme Park such as Jurassic World, The Mummy, The Simpsons, Harry Potter and Transformers.

Pupils also participated in a film-making workshop at the New York Film Academy of LA in which they acted out a short script, planned (with a clapper board!), directed, filmed and made storytelling decisions with a Hollywood professional...the footage was sent to their post-production department and will eventually find its way to Media Studies lessons in the very near future.

The Hollywood Walk of Fame was visited too, with pupils able to find their favourite movie, TV and music stars immortalised in stone beneath their feet, as well as sampling classic American fayre at institutions such as Bubba Gump Shrimp and the Hard Rock Café.

The students were an absolute credit to both the school and themselves; no fewer than four of the places we visited complimented their behaviour and manners, and they were also praised by the Virgin cabin crew on their return trip too! It was a phenomenal experience (for the staff, too!) and I'm sure they'll have made memories which last a lifetime. Thank you to everyone who helped make the trip happen!
