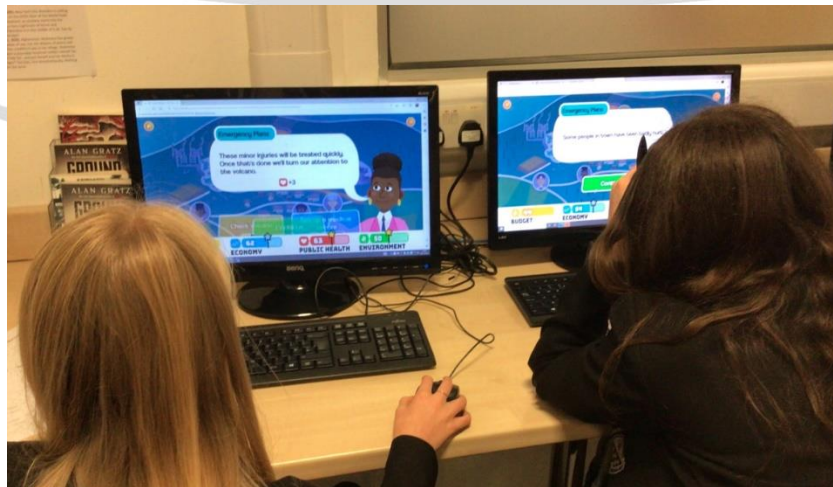
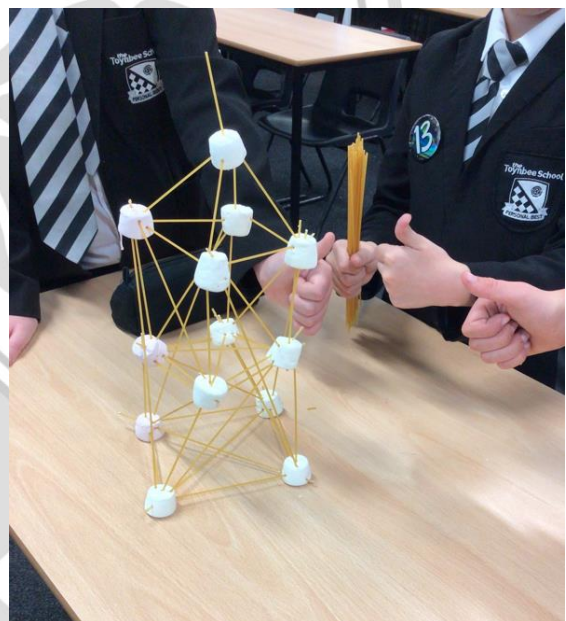
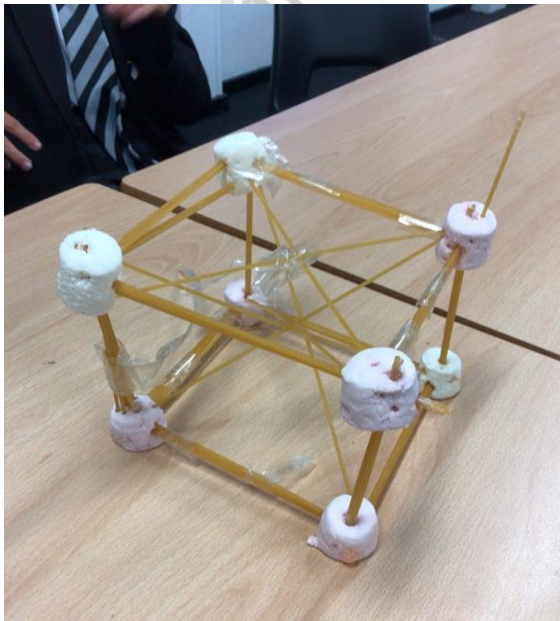

A Young Carer is someone under 18 who takes on physical, practical or emotional responsibilities at home because someone in their family is disabled, has been ill for a long time, experiences mental ill health, has a learning disability or has a problem linked to addiction.

Toynbee School endeavours to identify and offer the support that our young carers need to ensure they can attend and enjoy school and achieve their full potential. If your child is a young carer, or you think your child may be a young carer and would benefit from extra support please don't hesitate to get in touch.

Every Wednesday morning, we run a drop-in support group for our young carers where we offer a free hot breakfast. The club is an opportunity for them to receive pastoral support, make new friends with others, enjoy games and activities and have a more positive start to their day.

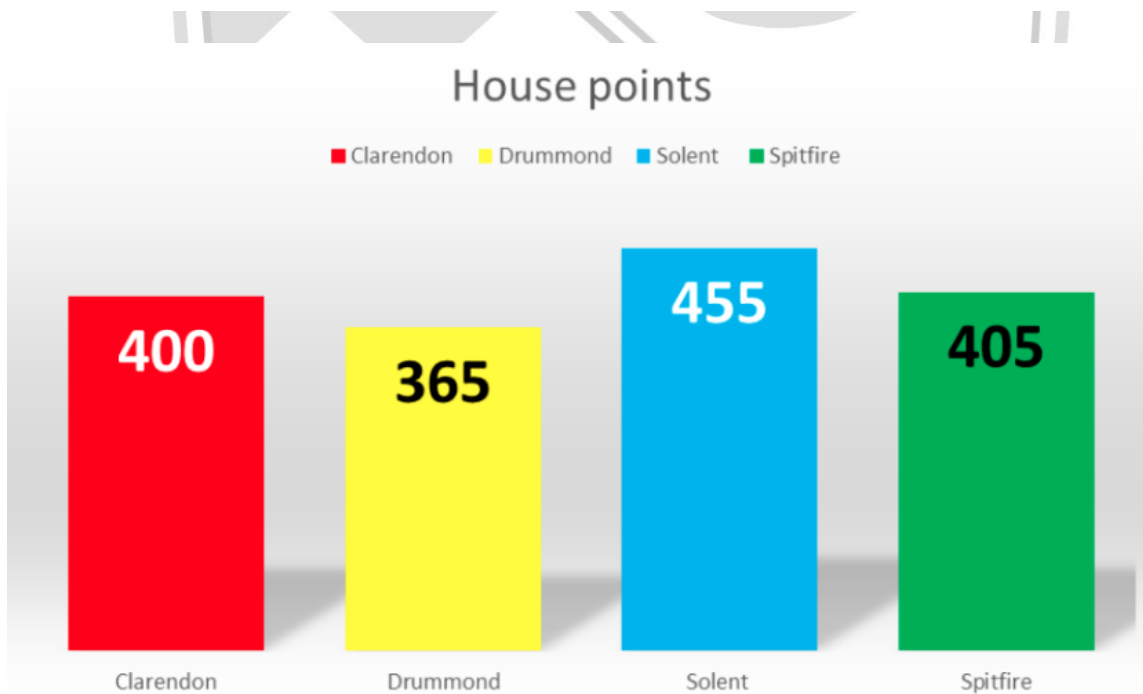
