If you feel you need to talk to somebody, you can set up an account online and you will have access to live chat counselling, Mon-Fri 12-10pm Sat and Sun 6-10pm. All young people need to do is join the queue to speak to someone, they can then arrange a follow up with the same counsellor or join the queue again another day. There is also a 24-hour messaging service where a counsellor should reply within a day!

Kooth also has an online magazine (young people can contribute articles if they would like to), activity hub, private journal space for mood tracking, discussion boards and live forums.













Personal Development

A Young Carer is someone under 18 who takes on physical, practical or emotional responsibilities at home because someone in their family is disabled, has been ill for a long time, experiences mental ill health, has a learning disability or has a problem linked to addiction.

Toynbee School endevours to identify and offer the support that our young carers need to ensure they can attend and enjoy school and achieve their full potential. If your child is a young carer, or you think your child may be a young carer and would benefit from extra support please don't hesitate to get in touch.

Every Wednesday morning, we run a drop-in support group for our young carers where we offer a free hot breakfast. The club is an opportunity for them to receive pastoral support, make new friends with others, enjoy games and activities and have a more positive start to their day.




