<b>Parochialism</b>	Focus on one's own area
<b>Significance</b>	The relative importance of something
<b>Plague</b>	Disease, sometimes referred to as the Black Death, that ravaged Europe on several occasions in the Medieval and Early Modern eras
<b>Armaments</b>	Weapons
<b>Home Front</b>	The life and conditions of those at 'home' during wartime
<b>Windrush Generation</b>	Generation of immigrants who emigrated from the British Empire/Commonwealth in the post-WWII period
