### Lesson Sequence:

**Puberty** We are learning about how the emotions are affected by puberty, how this may affect relationships and how to manage this Pupils will learn the main physical and emotional changes experienced during puberty & how relationships can be affected during puberty. We will also look at strategies for managing the emotional aspects of puberty.

Menstrual Wellbeing, We are learning about menstrual (period) wellbeing. They will learn how to challenge assumptions and stereotypes about menstruation

We are learning about the qualities of healthy and unhealthy relationships. Pupils will be able to describe the features of different committed, stable, healthy relationships &how to identify healthy and unhealthy relationship behaviours.

### **Managing Conflict**
