Exploring Attitudes

Is the first of four lessons for Year 9, focusing on the risks and consequences of drug use. We asses current understanding of drugs, explore attitudes towards their use and clarify perceptions regarding the prevalence of drug use

Managing risk, the second lesson moves on to the risks and consequences of drug use. This lesson will teach

students about the law in relation to drugs.

Alcohol and cannabis

the third lesson explores the effects of different patterns of alcohol use, in addition to the health risks associated with alcohol and cannabis use

Managing influences

is the last of four lessons focusing on the risks and consequences of drug use. This lesson

develops skills and strategies to manage pressure in and influence relation to substances.

Vaping

In this lesson pupils explore the consequences of vaping and challenging the influences that might encourage young people to vape.
